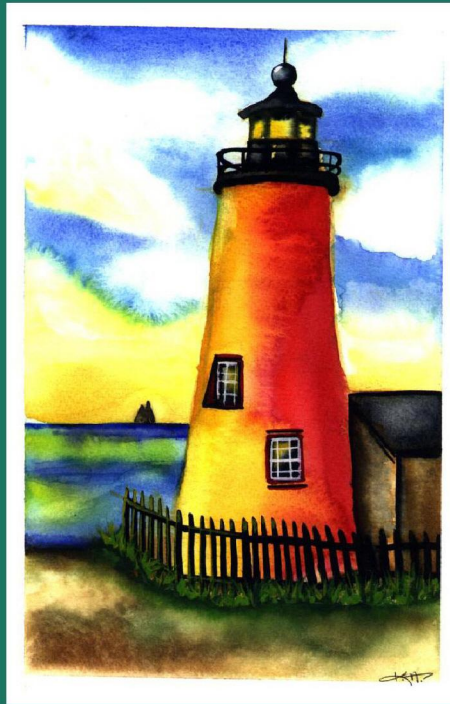

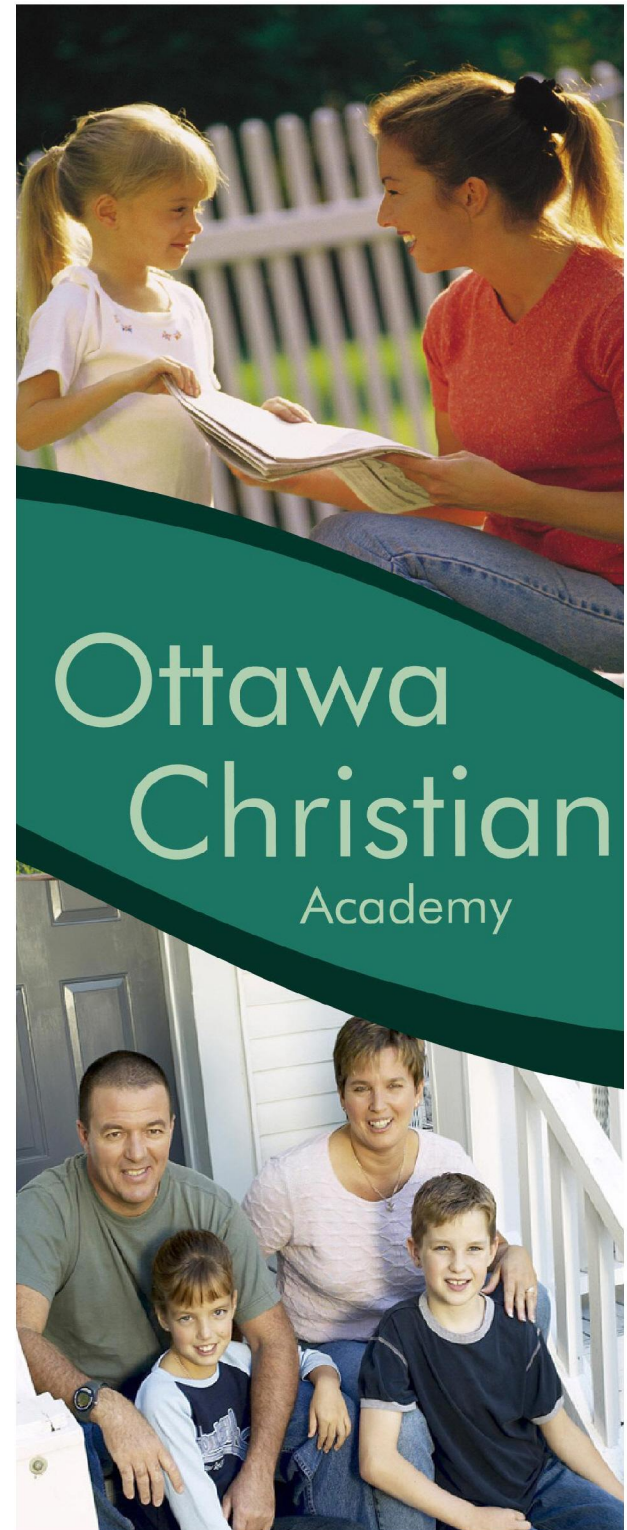

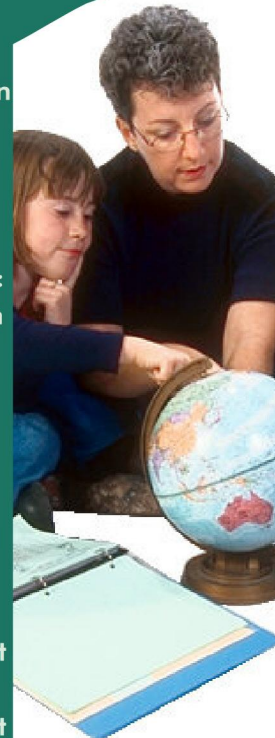
Accelerated Christian Education offers individualized core curriculum in the areas of Mathematics, English, Social Studies, Science, and Word Building that meet the students where they are academically as well as individually.

How They Learn...

With A.C.E., we believe in the philosophy of learning *not just teaching* for academic results.

The "5" Laws of Learning :

1. starting the student on a level where he can perform.
2. student setting goals that can be achieved.
3. student being controlled yet motivated to interact with the material.
4. student's learning must be measurable
5. student's learning must be rewarded



Activities

There is lots to do at the Ottawa Christian Academy! Besides daily recess on our equipped playground where we have basketball hoops and room for outdoor games, we also have our hourly in-school breaks where students regularly engage in ping-pong, chess, checkers and other board games.

In addition to recreation, the O.C.A partners with several local Christian schools twice weekly for physical education and participation in athletic competitions for both our junior and senior students.

We also have other opportunities for students to compete in a higher level of athletic events. **See Pastor Dan for more info.

Different field trips are scheduled each year that offer our students fun and new learning experiences.

For students who are 13 yrs. old and older, we participate in the National A.C.E. Convention. This expanded overnight trip allows students to compete and earn awards along with other schools in a wide variety of categories that span the fine arts (performing & medium arts), athletics, academics and even gaming talents.

Quarterly and at the end of the year, parents and faculty get to attend an awards ceremony to acknowledge academic achievement as well as graduation for our seniors.
